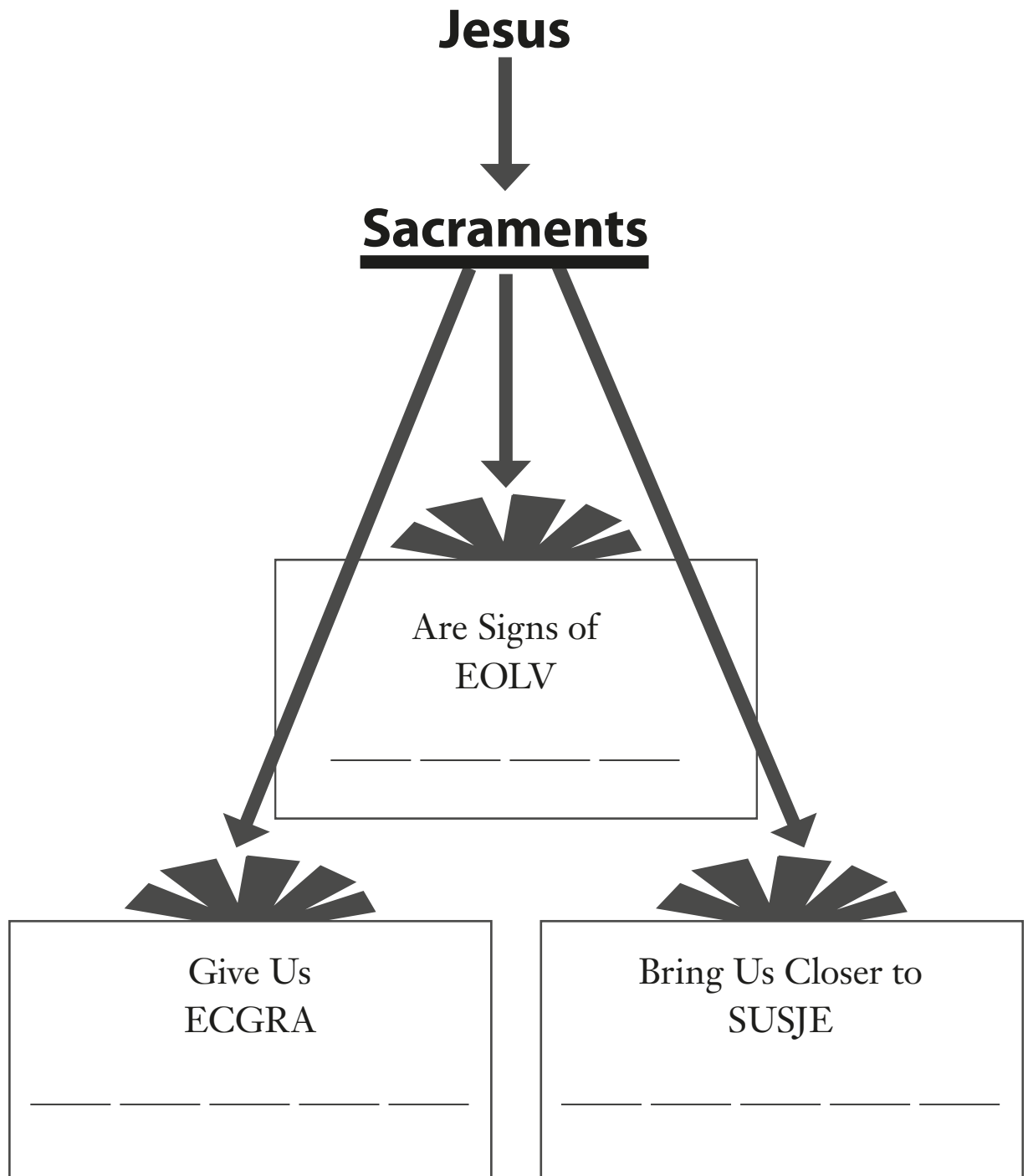
*In John 13:34–35, Jesus gives his disciples a new commandment. He tells them to love one another as he has loved them. Jesus wants us to love and care for others too.*
