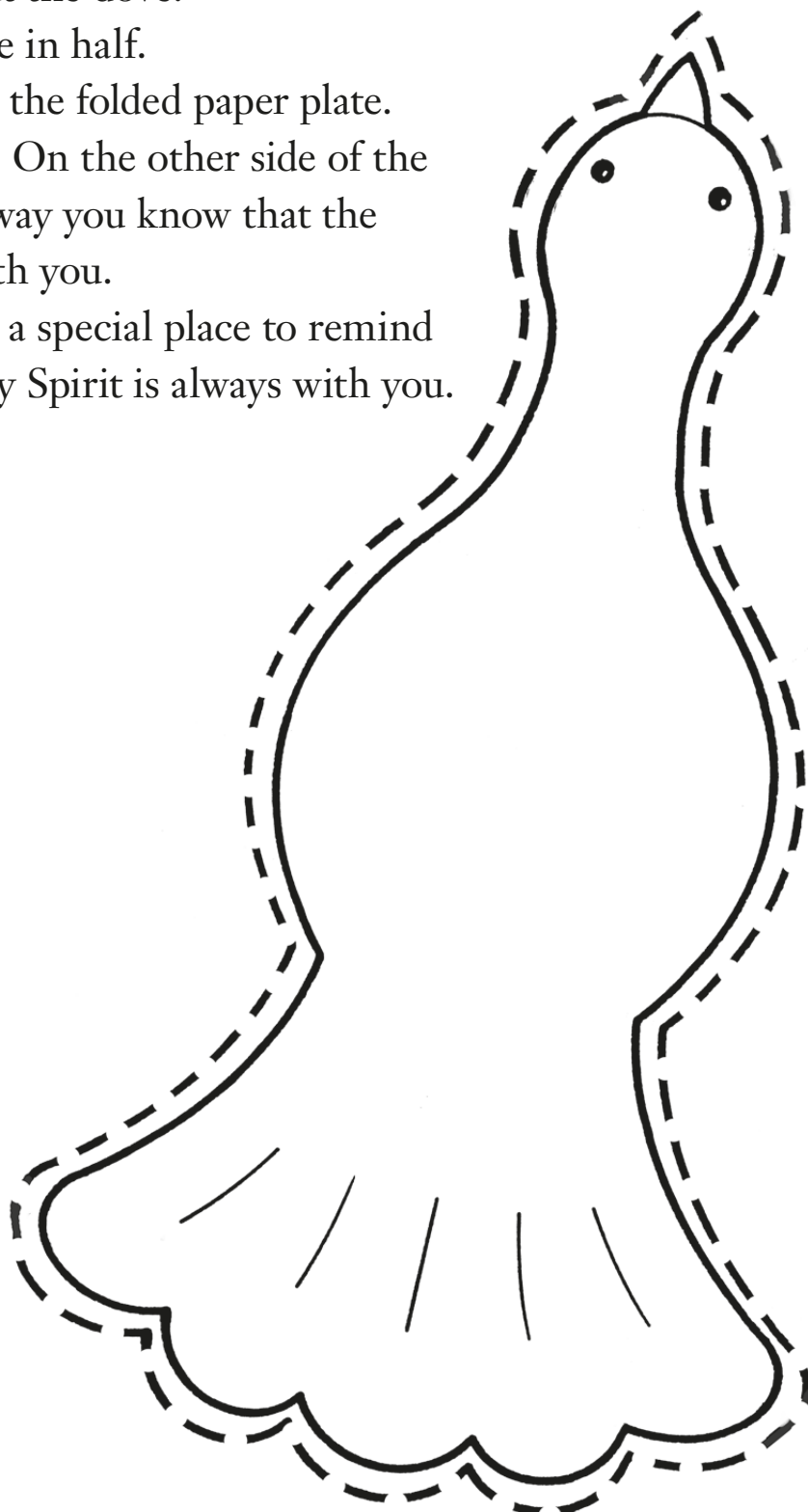




Holy Spirit Dove
