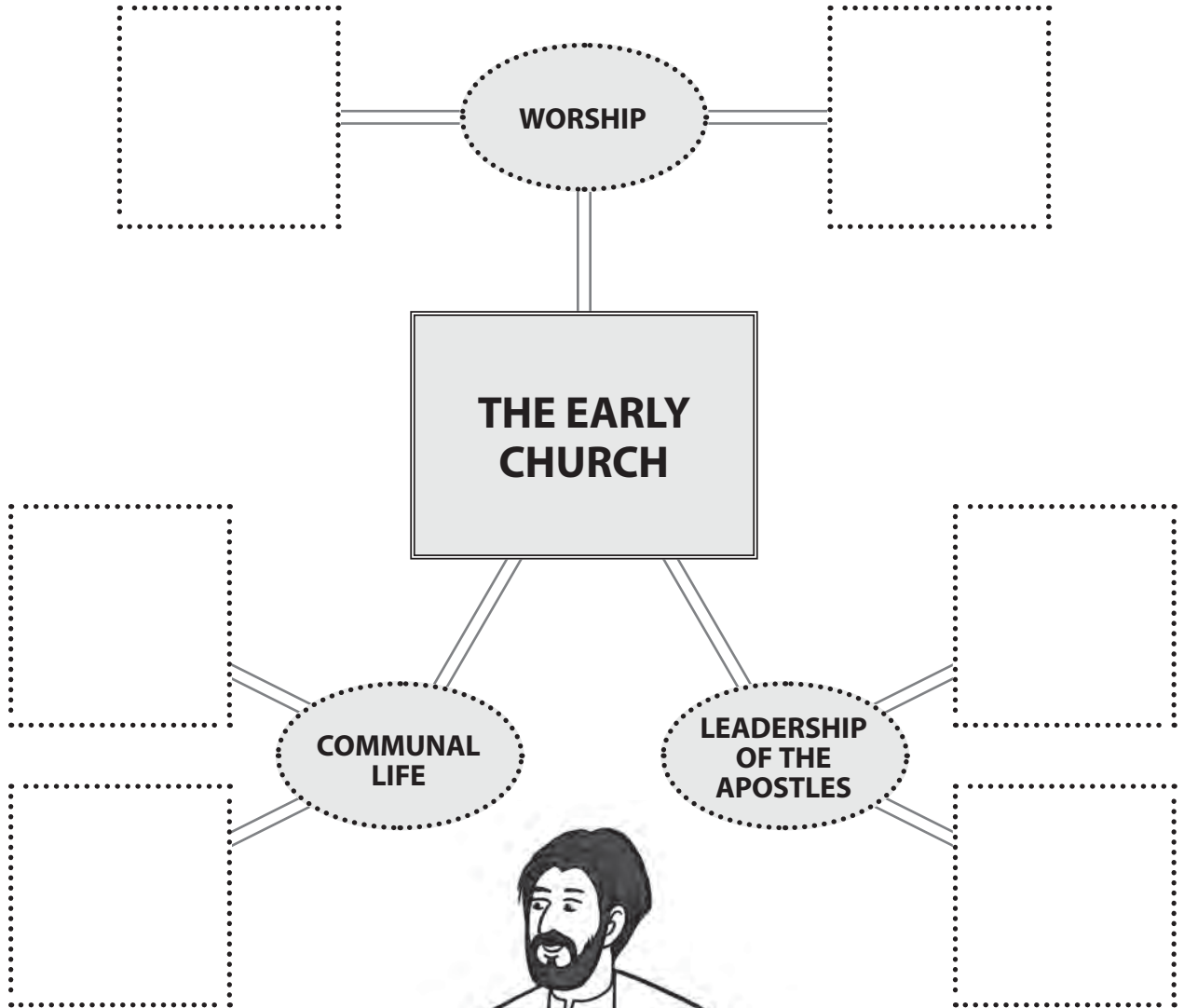


Acts of the Apostles 2:42–47
