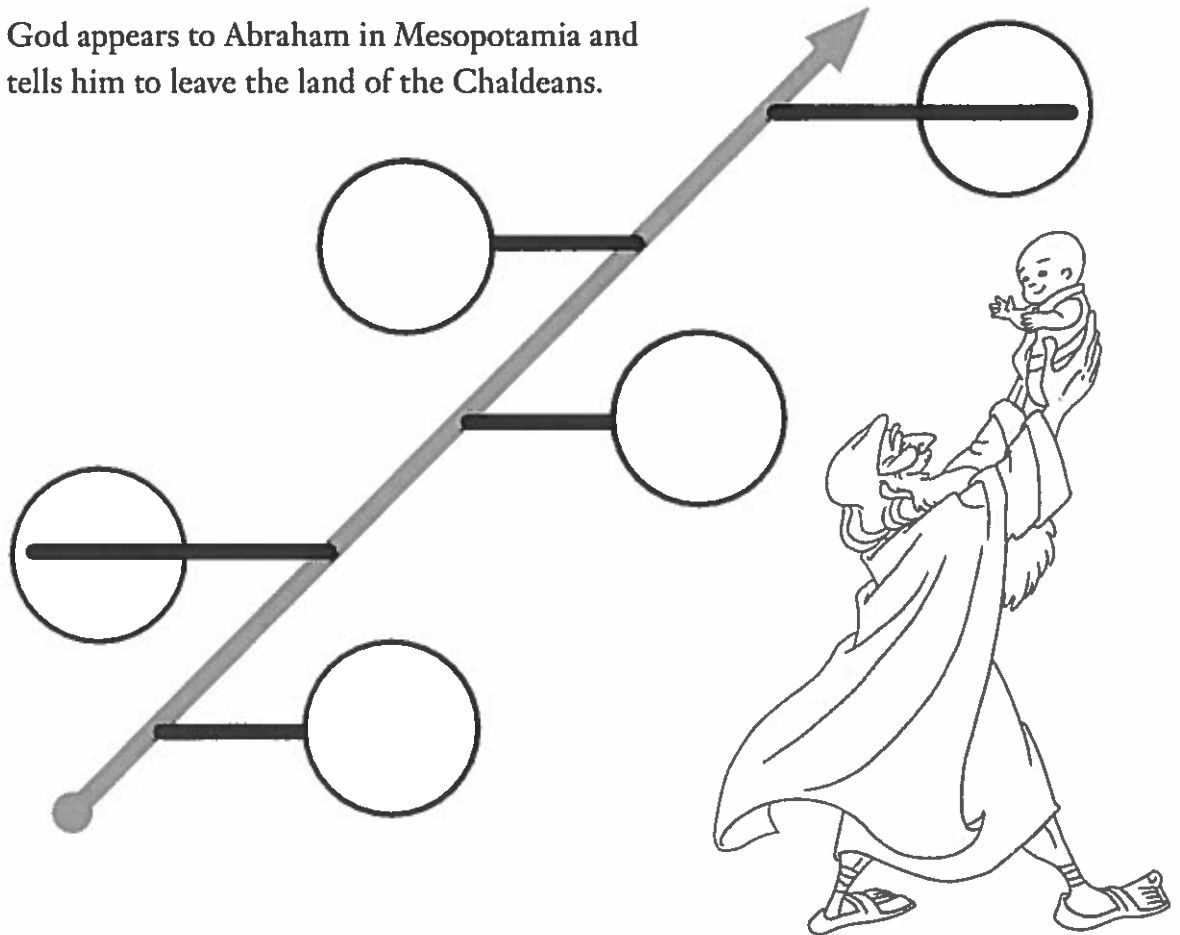


# Acts of the Apostles 7:1–8

*Acts of the Apostles 7:1–8 records part of Saint Stephen’s speech before the Sanhedrin, in which he recounts how God made a covenant with Abraham.*

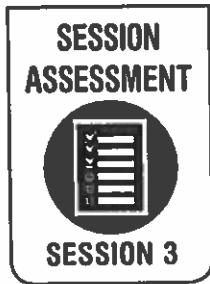

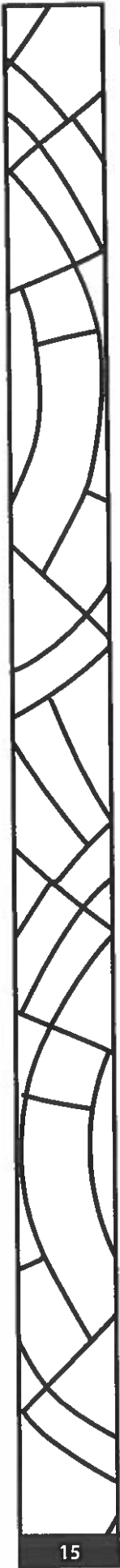
