Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. PARENTS must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance—before any social plans. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed and returned, a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

RECONCILIATION:

Individual Confessions Saturdays, 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS: Parishioners desiring the Sacraments, please contact the Parish Office.

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, "This is my Body" and "This is my Blood," Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on March 7th. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament continues from the conclusion of 8:00 am daily Mass on First Friday until the beginning of 12:15 pm Mass that very same day.** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: "I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always."

March 2nd, 2025 - 8th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today is the last Sunday in Ordinary Time before Lent begins, and, boy, does Jesus have some things to say to us! All of the readings are pointing to the idea that if we are believers in the One True God, people ought to know it by our words and actions. Jesus Himself tells us that our actions will show people what kind of people we really are. As we approach the Lenten season, it's time for us to take stock of our souls and make reconciliation where it's needed – whether that's with God or with our friends or family. If we have wronged someone, we need to make amends. And if we've been wronged . . . well, then we need to forgive. As we enter into Lent, let us all re-focus ourselves on Christ and join ourselves to His suffering so we can also join Him in His Resurrection.

Next Sunday at 10am Mass we will celebrate the Rite of Sending and Call to Continuing Conversion. We will 'send' our catechumens (unbaptized) to the Cathedral for the Rite of Election that afternoon. The Lenten season is their final preparation phase. As Catholic Christians, it is our fundamental mission to support and encourage those children of God who wish to become part of the Catholic Faith Family. Please keep our catechumens and candidates in your prayers.

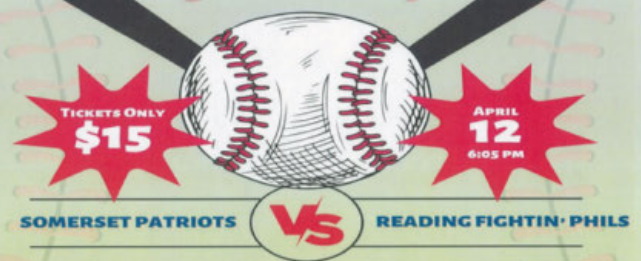
