Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. PARENTS must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance—before any social plans. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed and returned, a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

RECONCILIATION:

Individual Confessions Saturdays, 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS: Parishioners desiring the Sacraments, please contact the Parish Office.

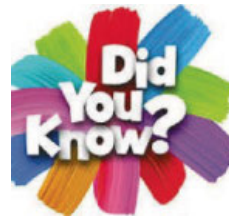

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, “This is my Body” and “This is my Blood,” Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on April 4th. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament continues from the conclusion of 8:00 am daily Mass on First Friday until the beginning of 12:15 pm Mass that very same day.** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: “I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always.”

2025 Lenten Obligations for the Diocese of Metuchen

The days of both fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday (March 5) and Good Friday (April 18).

- Fasting in the Roman Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal with two smaller meals which together do not equal the size of your full meal.
- The obligation of fasting applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.

The other Fridays of Lent (Mar. 7, 14, 21, 28; April 4, and 11) are days of abstinence.

Abstinence in the Roman Catholic tradition means to abstain from eating meat (beef, chicken, pork, turkey, etc.).

- The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.

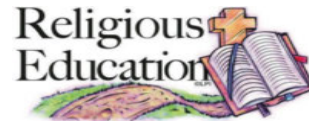


March 9th, 2025 - 1st Sunday of Lent

Today, on the first Sunday of Lent, in every diocese throughout the world, catechumens celebrate, with their Bishop, the Rite of Election. **Our Catechumens**

Patricia, Justin, Richard and Saimir, will join catechumens from other parishes in the Diocese on Sunday afternoon at the Cathedral with Bishop Checchio. Candidates from our Diocese will celebrate the Rite of Calling Candidates to Continuing Conversion in their home parish. **Our parish's candidates, Antonio, Hailey, Harold, Matthew, Renee and Stefanie will celebrate that Rite at the 10am Mass.**

Every first Sunday of Lent we hear of Our Lord's temptation in the desert, close to the beginning of our own forty-day journey. Jesus was led into the desert for an express purpose: "to be tempted by the devil." God permits temptation for a greater good. Temptation is a battleground where we can exercise virtue and rely more firmly on Him. In the first temptation, the devil tells Jesus to turn a stone into bread—a temptation for power. However, Jesus reminds us that we were created for more than our bodily desires: We are body and soul. Last, the devil dares Jesus to throw Himself off the temple in Jerusalem—a temptation to show His glory as the Son of God. The devil has the audacity to quote the Word of God to the Word Himself. The devil also knows Scripture . . . and recognizes the power of it and Jesus counters the devil each time by quoting Scripture. The devil presents temptations dealing with kingdoms, power, and glory, but these do not ultimately belong to him. At Mass, we proclaim, "For Thine is the kingdom, the power, and the glory, now and forever." May we glorify God in all that we do today! **Next Sunday at the 10am Mass we will celebrate the Penitential Rite with our baptized candidates. This rite prepares our candidates for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.**
