Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. **PARENTS** must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance—**before** any social plans. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed and returned, a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

RECONCILIATION:

Individual Confessions Saturdays, 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS: Parishioners desiring the Sacraments, please contact the Parish Office.

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, “This is my Body” and “This is my Blood,” Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on April 4th. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament continues from the conclusion of 8:00 am daily Mass on First Friday until the beginning of 12:15 pm Mass that very same day.** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: “I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always.”

2025 Lenten Obligations for the Diocese of Metuchen

The days of both fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday (March 5) and Good Friday (April 18).

- Fasting in the Roman Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal with two smaller meals which together do not equal the size of your full meal.
- The obligation of fasting applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.

The other Fridays of Lent (Mar. 7, 14, 21, 28; April 4, and 11) are days of abstinence.

Abstinence in the Roman Catholic tradition means to abstain from eating meat (beef, chicken, pork, turkey, etc.).

- The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.



Parents who are having their first child baptized are required to attend a Baptism Preparation session in advance.

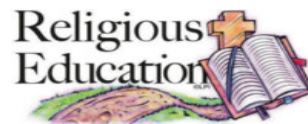
OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)



March 16, 2025 - 2nd Sunday of Lent

At the 10am Mass, we celebrate the Penitential Rite with our baptized candidates. This rite prepares them to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time. Have you ever found yourself watching a television show or talking on the phone and you started to fall asleep? You try to pay attention to the program, the other person, but you can't quite keep your eyes open. You start to drift off, missing a few words here, a couple sentences there. Soon, you're not quite sure what's happening and if you are talking to a friend, they'll have told you to go to bed. Reflecting on this incredible reading, the Transfiguration, I couldn't help but notice a line I've missed all these years. Luke says "Peter and his companions had been overcome by sleep, but becoming fully awake, they saw his glory..." Did you catch that? They were sleeping! For the whole conversation Jesus had with Moses and Elijah about what was going to happen in Jerusalem! It's only as the two men were leaving that the disciples managed to open their sleepy eyes and recognize the miracle before them. How often are we asleep to the miracles around us? How often do we miss an encounter with our Lord because we weren't paying attention? We are challenged to consider how awake we are in our daily encounters with Jesus.

Next Sunday at the 10am Mass, our elect, will celebrate the FIRST SCRUTINY. The scrutinies are among the most ancient prayers in the Christian liturgical tradition. As early as the second century, Christian communities would help those who had been chosen for Baptism to prepare for their initiation by laying on hands and by prayers for protection and deliverance from evil. We will use the "scrutiny readings" from cycle A at the Mass. All are invited.
