Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. PARENTS must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance—before any social plans. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed and returned, a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

Individual Confessions Saturdays, 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, “This is my Body” and “This is my Blood,” Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on April 4th. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be from 11:00am - 12:00pm, Mass will follow at 12:15pm.** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: “I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always.”

2025 Lenten Obligations for the Diocese of Metuchen

The days of both fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday (March 5) and Good Friday (April 18).

- Fasting in the Roman Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal with two smaller meals which together do not equal the size of your full meal.
- The obligation of fasting applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.

The other Fridays of Lent (Mar. 7, 14, 21, 28; April 4, and 11) are days of abstinence.

Abstinence in the Roman Catholic tradition means to abstain from eating meat (beef, chicken, pork, turkey, etc.).

- The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.

March 23, 2025 - 3rd Sunday of Lent

The woman left her water jar. The woman at the well is a reminder to us that Jesus doesn't come for the faithful – He comes for the unbaptized, the uninformed, and the unknowing. And He doesn't come to judge – He comes to us to be in an authentic relationship — first. He wants to know us personally, intimately. The woman left her water jar . . . and really her whole life behind and risked everything to announce the Gospel to a community that had already rejected her — after just one encounter with Jesus. Perhaps her brokenness is why Jesus picked her. Jesus always chooses the underdog. The least prepared. The most forgotten.

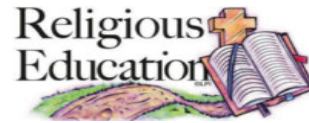
Today at the 10am mass, the first of three scrutinies will be celebrated with the elect of our parish (who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil Mass). The scrutinies afford the elect and the community the opportunity to examine our hearts and minds by the light of the gospel. Scrutinies are intended to heal what is weak, defective and sinful, and to protect the elect from temptation and to strengthen them in Christ. The first scrutiny focuses on the gospel story of the Samaritan woman at the well. That gospel story allows us to encounter the sins that prevent us from quenching our thirst with the "Living Water", who is Jesus our Redeemer. Please pray for the Elect as they journey towards baptism.

Next Sunday they will celebrate the second scrutiny.



Parents who are having their first child baptized are required to attend a Baptism Preparation session in advance.

Next class: Tuesday, March 25th - 7:00pm in the Parish Room of the Pastoral Center. **Registration required.** The Sacrament of Baptism is a sacred event regulated by Church (Canon) Law. Any questions - call 732.251.4000.


