Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. PARENTS must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance—before any social plans. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed and returned, a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

RECONCILIATION:

Individual Confessions Saturdays, 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS: Parishioners desiring the Sacraments, please contact the Parish Office.

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, "This is my Body" and "This is my Blood," Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on May 2nd. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be from Mass will follow at 12:15pm.** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: "I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always."

What a blessing that we have so many good, holy priests faithfully serving in the Diocese of Metuchen in our parishes, hospitals and other important ministries! I write to remind you that we also have forty retired priests of our diocese who have dedicated many years of devotion to God and our parish communities.

While all of our retired diocesan priests receive a monthly stipend to assist them with expenses, some go to live with relatives, while twelve live at our *Maria Regina Residence for Retired Priests*. Here our retired priests live each day with dignity while being able to live in community with brother priests. Those who are physically able continue to generously help in so many ways—offering Mass at local parishes, hearing confessions and sharing their spiritual and administrative wisdom with their brother priests. They also spend time in prayer in their chapel praying for the needs of everyone in our diocese, including you.

Our retired priests have served so many people over the course of their ministry, nourishing our Catholic faith, educating our youth and serving the poor and vulnerable. *Next weekend, April 12 and 13, as we celebrate Palm Sunday*, the faithful of the diocese will have the opportunity to gratefully acknowledge the life-long dedication of these priests by contributing to the *Annual Collection for our Retired Diocesan Priests*. All funds raised through this collection will be used exclusively to assist our retired priests.

Thank you for your generosity. Please keep all of our priests in your daily prayers. Please also continue to pray for vocations from our local Church to the holy priesthood for service in our diocese.

2025 Lenten Obligations for the Diocese of Metuchen

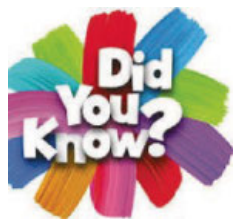
The days of both fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday (March 5) and Good Friday (April 18).

- Fasting in the Roman Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal with two smaller meals which together do not equal the size of your full meal.
- The obligation of fasting applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.

The other Fridays of Lent (Mar. 7, 14, 21, 28; April 4, and 11) are days of abstinence.

Abstinence in the Roman Catholic tradition means to abstain from eating meat (beef, chicken, pork, turkey, etc.).

- The obligation of abstinence applies to all Catholics who have reached the age of 14.



The Diocese of Metuchen's Office of Hospital Chaplaincy, overseen by Rev. Sean Winters, provides pastoral care for the sick in hospitals and healthcare institutions within the Diocese's four counties, with a focus on spiritual support and sacramental needs.

A hospital chaplain is a specially trained spiritual professional who provides spiritual and emotional comfort to patients, families, and staff in a hospital setting, offering guidance and understanding during challenging times.

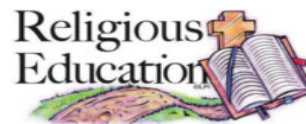
OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)



April 6, 2025 - 5th Sunday of Lent

This Gospel stirs up lots of human emotions like sadness, anguish, happiness and suspense, all in one story. It's long, it's intense, and it's powerful but there is one line that just jumps right off the page. "And even now I know that whatever you ask from God, God will give you." The faith and confidence demonstrated by Martha in that one sentence shows us a huge serving of inspiration and hope! She saw beyond her personal sadness and grief. She didn't cry and scream and bargain, she trusted that Jesus would ask His Father for the perfect thing, it would be given, and she would accept it as just that...the perfect thing. Life is full of events that are difficult and often the timing of these events makes the burden even greater to bear. Those are truths that all of us face. God's love for us isn't measured by the absence of pain and grief. Even Jesus felt it in this Gospel. Verse 35 says, Jesus wept. It's important to remember that Jesus also healed, gave sight, loved, shared, and raised the dead. He came to deliver us from the deadly power of sin and raise us to everlasting life with Him just as he raised his friend Lazarus.

At the 10am Mass this Sunday, the third of three scrutinies will be celebrated with the elect of our parish, who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil. Today's scrutiny calls upon the elect, and the community to examine the death-dealing power of the spirit of evil and to proclaim the power of Jesus Christ to remove the stones that hold us back from life, to break the ties that bind us, and to set us free to live life fully. Please continue to pray for our Elect and candidates.
