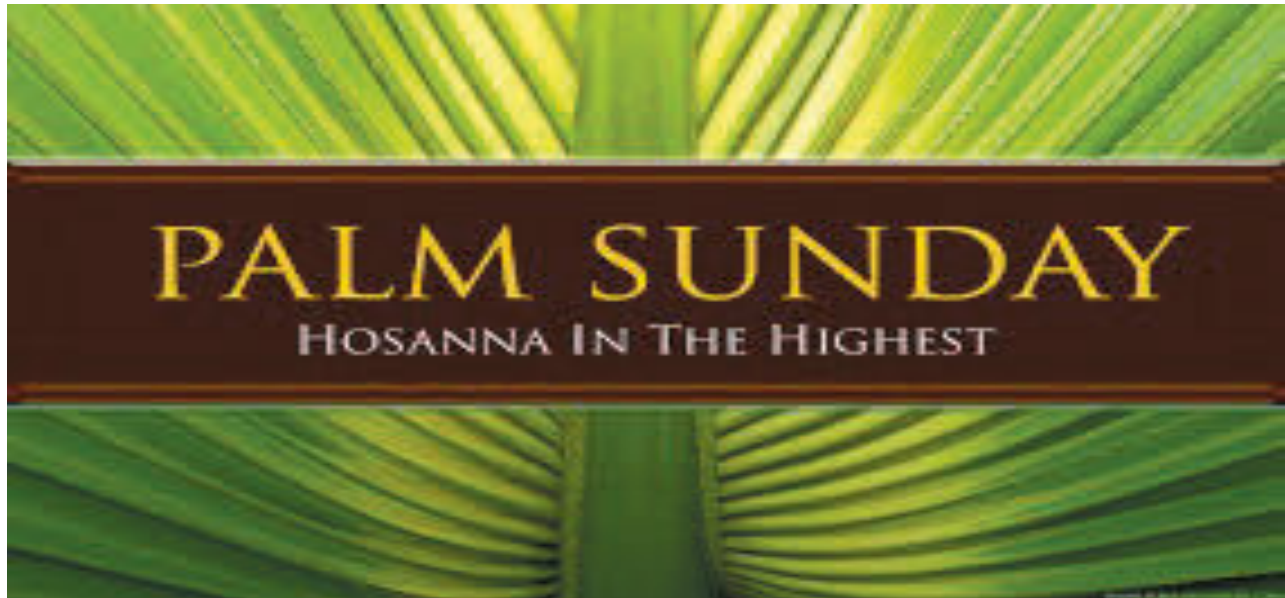

Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. PARENTS must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance—before any social plans. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed and returned, a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

RECONCILIATION:

Individual Confessions Saturdays, 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS: Parishioners desiring the Sacraments, please contact the Parish Office.

Sanctuary Candle/Mary Candle, lit for one week in Church, available during daytime by contacting the Parish Office.

Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, “This is my Body” and “This is my Blood,” Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on May 2nd. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be from Mass will follow at 12:15pm.** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: “I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always.”

April 13, 2025 - Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Today's gospel begins the most wondrous week in mankind's history. Imagine how the Apostles must have felt entering Jerusalem. Here they were, following behind Jesus, being lauded by an entire multitude of people. They believed, by the crowd's reception, the coming week was going to be the best ever! And so, as they gathered to celebrate the Passover dinner, they were ready to party. All had observed this holy day before, but tonight was so much more special. Can you almost hear the laughter and happiness as they gathered; feel the love emanating among them as they took their seats. And then Our Lord announces how he 'greatly desired to eat this Passover with you...before I suffer.' If ever there was a conversation stopper, this was it! I'm sure the laughter and conversation slowly came to a halt as the feeling of joy was replaced with one of fear. They loved Him and knew He always spoke the truth. His suffering was going to be real and their sadness must have been evident. And amid this feeling of the unknown, sensing their pain, Christ offered them hope. He gave them the gift of His Body and His Blood. This First Eucharist was His promise to always be there for them, throughout not only the next few days, but their entire lives. Like them, we will experience different emotions and feelings on any given day. We need to bring them to His Table and allow ourselves to be filled with His Body and Blood. When we are able to do this, we are accepting Him into our lives. And, just as He did at the Last Supper, He will replace all our fears with hope. This Holy Week is the final preparation for our Elect and Candidates! Please keep them in your prayers.

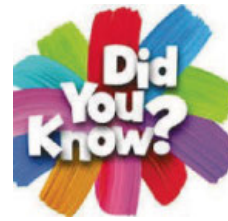
