Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. **PARENTS** must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made **at least one year in advance** - before any social plans. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed and returned, a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

RECONCILIATION:

Individual Confessions Saturdays, 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS: Parishioners desiring the Sacraments, please contact the Parish Office.

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshiping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, "This is my Body" and "This is my Blood," Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on November 7th for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: "I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always."

VOCATION MINISTRY

Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time - October 5, 2025 "If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." (Luke 17:6) Even small steps of faith can lead to great things. Show your children how their faith can grow, allowing them to explore whether God is calling them to a vocation in His Church. Remind them that God will provide the strength they need to follow His path, even if it's not yet clear.

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)



October 5, 2025 - Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

All of the readings emphasize the importance of faith. Every Sunday we come together to celebrate in word and sacrament the mystery of our faith, the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus, the Son of God. This faith is ours through a community of faith called the Church and in each of us through the sacrament of our Baptism into the Paschal Mysteries of Christ. This gift, like the small mustard seed, is to grow constantly within us and in the Church so that even the miraculous is possible for those who believe. Faith for Christians is belief that because Christ is risen from the dead, we will do the same. Jesus used the picture of a tiny seed to move a mighty mulberry tree as a metaphor for faith being the greatest force in the world. Even on a purely natural plane, things that look impossible become possible when approached with faith. The rest of the Gospel passage teaches the disciples the necessity of being humble in the service of God. In words that don't apply to other areas like labour management relations, Jesus says that we can never have any claim on God. Our greatest response to the Giver of divine faith is works of service. Do you know someone who would like to learn more about Jesus, and how we can follow him through the Catholic Faith? All who are unbaptized, baptized into another faith denomination, or baptized Catholic but have not received Eucharist and Confirmation, are invited. 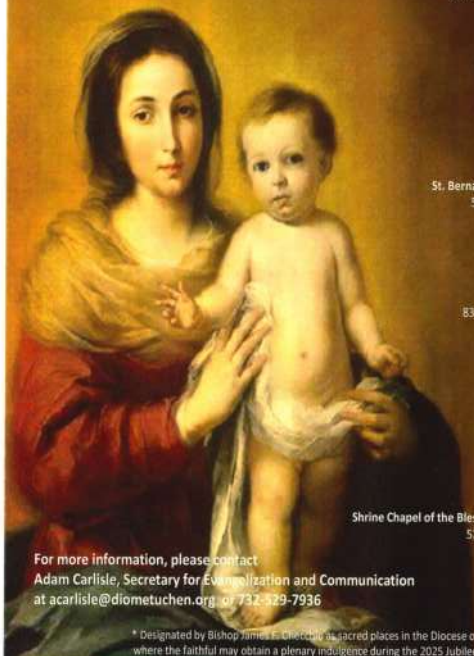
