Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. **PARENTS** must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made **at least one year in advance** - before any social plans. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed and returned, a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

Individual Confessions Saturdays, 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshiping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, "This is my Body" and "This is my Blood," Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on November 7th for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: "I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always."

Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

As the lepers were doing exactly what Jesus asked they were made whole again. They certainly would have wanted to stay and let this man with a reputation for healing do His magic on them. But instead He told them to leave and go visit the priests in the temple even though they were still unclean. Did they think He was crazy? Did they talk amongst themselves in doubt while walking away from this so-called healer they had heard about? We don't know; all that is recorded in today's Gospel is that as soon as Jesus told them to go, they left and did exactly what He asked. They trusted Him enough to follow His unusual instructions. The lepers didn't hesitate to yell out to Jesus when they saw Him coming, or when He told them to do something that sounded crazy. How often do we get a nudge from the Holy Spirit that we should do something to help someone or volunteer our time but we hesitate in doubt? We need to follow the lead of these faithful lepers and listen to what Jesus is telling us without hesitation. Then we, too, can be saved by our faith. Honor Our Veterans

In the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918, World War I ended when the Armistice with Germany went into effect. Formerly known as Armistice Day when President Woodrow Wilson declared it one year later, Veterans Day this year marks the 105th anniversary of the end of WWI.

Not to be confused with Memorial Day, which remembers and honors those who died while in service to our country, Veterans Day is the day set aside to thank our living veterans for their service to our country and to remember those veterans who have gone to their rest.

On Sunday, November 9th after the 10pm Mass, Saint Thomas the Apostle will honor the living and deceased veterans of our parish family at Saint Thomas the Apostle Church. Organized by the Saint Thomas the Apostle Knights of Columbus Council 4815, an American flag will be placed for your veteran, with their name, branch of service, and other pertinent information you wish to share in the lawn near the entrance of Saint Thomas the Apostle Church.
