Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. **PARENTS** must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made **at least one year in advance** - before any social plans. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed and returned, a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

RECONCILIATION:

Individual Confessions Saturdays, 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS: Parishioners desiring the Sacraments, please contact the Parish Office.

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshiping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, "This is my Body" and "This is my Blood," Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on February 6th for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: "I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always."

February 1 - Fourth Sunday on Ordinary Time

The Sermon on the Mount is the bridge between the Old and New Testaments, so beautifully woven into writing and also because the Beatitudes foreshadow or “whisper” the Works of Mercy’s primary appearance later in Matthew 25. It’s like Jesus is laying the groundwork for later...for our marching orders.

This encounter with Jesus must have been important – because we see imagery and references both backwards: to the language of Genesis, Isaiah, Chronicles and the Psalms – as well as forward: the “Blesseds” are referred to throughout all the other gospels as well as Acts, and letters from Peter, Paul, and James. We even see pieces of the Beatitudes in Revelation. The Beatitudes tell us who we are at our best, and who we are in our moments of most need. They teach us what we struggle with, and what we need to watch for in taking care of others. Mark Hart says “A soul with nothing to lose on earth is a wonderfully dangerous soul, a soul that will lead many to heaven.” We should all desire to be that soul. Please pray for our candidates this week, those who are actively seeking His love and truth, that their hearts may be open to the beauty of His grace.




