Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. PARENTS must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made at least one year in advance - before any social plans. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed and returned, a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

Individual Confessions Saturdays, 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

STEWARDSHIP SCRIPTURE REFLECTIONS

May 3, 2026 - 5th Sunday of Easter

“The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone.” (1 Peter 2:7)

Every person has been given gifts from the Holy Spirit. These are called “charisms” and they are used to build God’s kingdom on earth. While many people are able to recognize their natural talents and abilities, they may be unsure of their charisms. If you know someone who is struggling for a direction in life, give them a little encouragement. Help them discern their charisms and how God is calling them to use them. Remember - no gift is too small or insignificant in

Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, “This is my Body” and “This is my Blood,” Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on June 5th, for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: “I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always.”

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)



May 3, 2026 - 5th Sunday of Easter

Thomas and Philip want direct answers and physical proofs of the Father and Heaven but received neither during this discourse. Do their demands remind you of anyone? While our material selves often reduce truth to simple concrete and physical proofs, Jesus goes beyond that. He appeals to the heart, using language that is intricate and sometimes obscure. True, Jesus performed many concrete miracles which these two men witnessed time and time again; but the reasons extend beyond providing simple, concrete proof. He loves and that moves Him to compassionately help those in need. Jesus wanted Philip and Thomas to respond in kind with their hearts rather than just their heads.

Today we are moved to believe "not because revealed truths appear as true and intelligible in light of natural reasoning but we believe because of the authority of God himself who reveals them, who can neither deceive nor be deceived. Do you know someone who would like to learn more about Jesus, his love for us, and how we can follow him through the Catholic Faith? 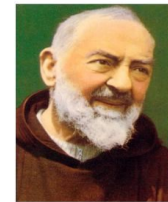

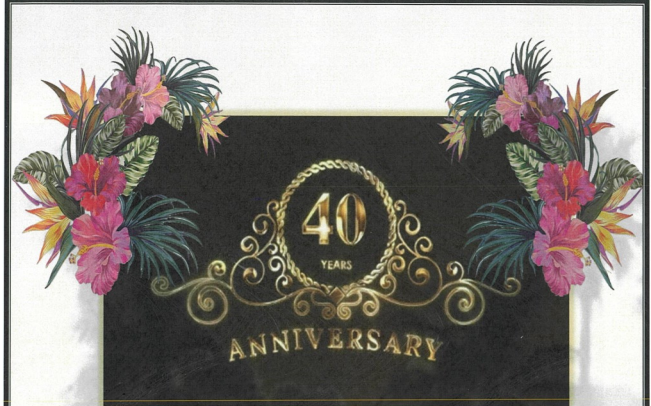


