Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. PARENTS must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session. (Registration is required.)

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made **at least one year in advance**. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center. A communal celebration of the Sacrament is held each year in the Spring.

RECONCILIATION:

Individual Confessions on Saturdays at 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS: Parishioners desiring the Sacraments, please contact the Parish Office.

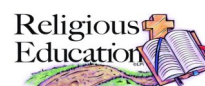


Eucharistic Adoration



Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, "This is my Body" and "This is my Blood," Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the Living God. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Join us on August 7th, for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** Please come and embrace Jesus in which you say to Him: "I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always."

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)



July 12, 2026 - Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Seeds of God's Promise

The 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time invites us to think about how God's word works in our lives. Each reading uses simple images from the world around us. Rain, seeds, soil, and harvest all show how God's word brings life and hope. These readings remind us that God always works with purpose. In Isaiah, we hear how God's word is like rain that makes the earth fruitful. Paul tells us in Romans that creation itself longs for freedom and shares in our hope. In the Gospel, Jesus uses the parable of the sower to teach us that our hearts must be ready to receive God's word. On this Sunday, these passages come together to remind us that God's plan is certain. His word nourishes us, even when life feels dry or hard. With open hearts, we can grow strong in faith and bear much fruit.

All who are unbaptized, baptized into another faith denomination, or baptized Catholic but have not received Eucharist and Confirmation, are invited. Applications available from May 1 to Sept. 15, 2026. No applications will be accepted after that date.



Parents who are having their first child baptized are required to attend a Baptism Preparation session in advance.

Next class: Tuesday, July 28th at 7:00pm in the Parish Room of the Pastoral Center. **Registration required.** The Sacrament of Baptism is a sacred event regulated by Church (Canon) Law.

SPONSOR LETTERS FOR BAPTISM & CONFIRMATION

To receive a sponsor letter to be a Godparent for a Baptism or Sponsor for Confirmation, the Sponsor must fulfill the following requirements:

1. Have received Baptism, Communion & Confirmation in the Catholic Church.
2. If married, you must have been married in the Catholic Church.
3. If divorced, you must not be remarried without having received an annulment for the first marriage.
4. Be a **registered and practicing** member of St. Thomas the Apostle Parish.

If you have moved out of the parish, and no longer live within our parish boundaries, we **CANNOT** give you a Sponsor Letter, even if you grew up here and made all your Sacraments here and your family still lives here. You are given a Sponsor Letter from the parish whose boundaries you live within currently.

5 Easy Ways to Grow Your Catholic Faith Over the Summer

1. Go on a Family Rosary Walk.

Take the whole family outside and pray the Rosary. Walk around your neighborhood, a local park, or even the beach. Have each child, teen or parent (or grandparent) say a Hail Mary or decade of the Rosary (if they feel confident) along the walk. This is a great way to get some exercise and praying together.

2. Start a "Saint of the Week" Tradition.

Each week, choose a specific saint and learn about them. There are different ways to teach your family about the saints — through [reading stories](#), visiting a [spiritual site](#), or watching an [educational program](#) detailing their life stories.

3. Create a Gratitude Jar.

Each day, or even week, individually write down things to be thankful for (it can be something small). At the end of the summer season, read the gratitude notes out loud for everyone to hear. This activity serves as a reminder to give thanks to God in a simple way.

4. Keep a Summer Faith Journal.

Write, reflect or even draw about personal faith experiences. Like the gratitude jar, share the journals as a family at the end of the summer.

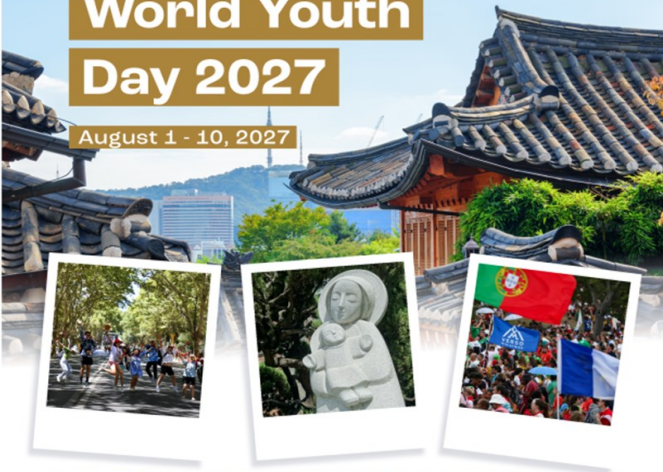
5. Host a Vacation Bible School at Home.

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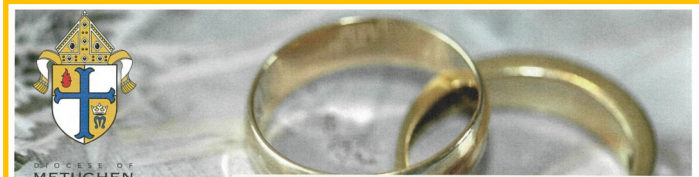
