Sacramental Information

BAPTISMS:

Sundays: 1:30pm, twice a month. The Church calls GODPARENTS, to be practicing Catholics, examples of Christ-centered living today. All Godparents should submit Sponsor letters from their Parish ASAP. PARENTS must attend a Baptismal Preparation Session.

MARRIAGES:

Arrangements must be made **at least one year in advance**. Either the bride or groom must be a registered member of our parish. Once the marriage questionnaire is completed a Parish Priest or Deacon will then contact the couple.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

In case of serious illness or accident, phone the Pastoral Center.

Individual Confessions on Saturdays at 12:30pm in the Church or by appointment by calling the Parish Office.

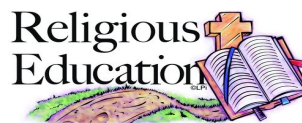
Bereavement Group at St. Thomas

Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Since the Last Supper, when Jesus broke the bread and distributed the wine saying, “This is my Body” and “This is my Blood,” Catholics have believed that the bread and wine are no longer merely baked wheat and fermented grape juice, but the actual living presence of the Second Person of the Trinity—Jesus Christ. Adoration occurs whenever someone kneels in front of a tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, genuflects toward a tabernacle, bows before receiving the Blessed Sacrament at Mass, or, in a more focused way, when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Adoration. **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament October 4th.**

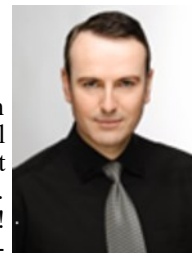
ST. MICHAEL the ARCHANGEL PRAYER

OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults)



September 20, 2026 - Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, Matthew recounts Jesus' parable about the Kingdom of Heaven. The landowner invites laborers throughout the day, from early morning to late afternoon. Those who arrived early expected more, a better reward than those who arrived at the last minute. Yet, at the end of the day, all receive the same reward or payment.

Imagine today is your sister's birthday. Think about a conversation siblings might have, how they often strive against each other to be the first – the favorite – in the family. However, when everything you do in your family feels like a competition, it drives a wedge between those relationships. Who should be first? Who should be last? Through this parable, Jesus reminds us that all who work for Him will enter the Kingdom of Heaven. Jesus invites us and welcomes us at every stage of life, at every age. And the promise of heaven is available to all. What matters is putting in the work. Serving God with humility, without comparison or care for status or position. Our OCIA sessions began last week. Please pray for our Inquirers as they begin their faith journey and discern whether God is calling them into full communion with the Catholic Church.

SPONSOR LETTERS FOR BAPTISM & CONFIRMATION

To receive a sponsor letter to be a Godparent for a Baptism or Sponsor for Confirmation, the Sponsor must fulfill the following requirements:

1. Have received Baptism, Communion & Confirmation in the Catholic Church.
2. If married, you must have been married in the Catholic Church.
3. If divorced, you must not be remarried without having received an annulment for the first marriage.
4. Be a **registered and practicing** member of St. Thomas the Apostle Parish.

If you have moved out of the parish, and no longer live within our parish boundaries, we CANNOT give you a Sponsor Letter, even if you grew up here and made all your Sacraments here and your family still lives here. You are given a Sponsor Letter from the parish whose boundaries you live within currently.

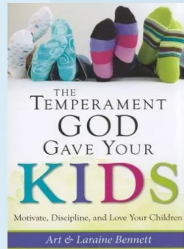
