Your Confirmation is an opportunity to enter into a deeper relationship with God and with the Church. One Confirmation custom is to choose a new name to symbolize this relationship. This is when you decide to choose a saint's name <u>OR</u> you may use your Baptismal name *if it is that of a recognized saint*.



The early Christians took new names to reflect their "new lives in Christ" when they were baptized. Catholic saints throughout the centuries have been models of faith. Saints are ordinary people who do extraordinary things because they have faith.

In choosing a saint's name for Confirmation, it should represent the direction of your faith journey. This saint will serve as your mentor and spiritual guide by selecting their name to research. It is important to learn something about the saint you have chosen. The saints continued Christ's work on earth. We are called to do the same by virtue of our Baptism.

OUTLINE FOR YOUR CONFIRMATION SAINT REPORT:

- 1. A cover sheet **MUST BE COMPLETED** and **ATTACHED** to your Saint Report.
- 2. Your Saint Report MUST BE TYPED AND AT LEAST ONE FULL PAGE (double-spaced).
- Your Saint Report must be turned in by MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 2024.

MAKE SURE THAT YOUR SAINT REPORT CONTAINS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Full name of your saint
- 2. Saint's Feast Day
- 3. Patron Saint of?
- 4. Background of your saint date of birth, where they lived and died.
- 5. Short biography of your saint miracles, contributions to the Church and society
- 6. Spiritual life and special qualities of your saint to be chosen for canonization.
- 7. Why did you choose this saint?
- 8. How can this saint help you to follow Jesus?
- 9. Include a picture of your chosen saint.
- 10. Compose a prayer to your saint or a favorite quote by your saint.

<u>ALL SAINT REPORTS WILL BE READ AND GRADED</u>. You must write this paper in your own words! If you use text directly from another source, you must cite the source and use quotation marks around the quoted text. You will need to do some research to complete your Saint Report. Ask your parents or sponsor to help you.
